On April 28th the Town of Jackson received notification from the Missionaries to the Pre-Born that they will be hosting pro-life demonstrations in Jackson, Wyoming on Monday, May 7. This group is separate from the Operation Save America group that is planning demonstrations at various locations in the community, May 16-20.

Missionaries to the Pre-Born have indicated that they will be at 900 West Broadway from approximately 10:45a.m.-12:30p.m. and at the intersection of highways 89 and 22, the "Y," from approximately 4:30 – 6:00p.m. No other demonstration locations or times were identified during discussions with the group.

Representatives of Missionaries to the Pre-Born have told Jackson Police Department administration that that they will be utilizing graphic signs and messages for their demonstration, similar to those utilized by Operation Save America during their 2011 demonstration.

When learning of this group's visit to Jackson, Mayor Mark Barron commented "Whether or not we agree with the message of this group, or the way in which they communicate their views, we will respect their right to express their beliefs both verbally and through images while providing for the safety of the community."

The Jackson Police Department is planning to manage the demonstrations with the intent to maintain public safety, keep the public informed, and to protect the rights of the demonstrators and residents as afforded by the United States Constitution.
